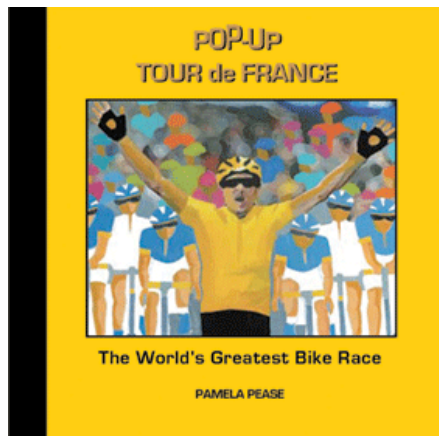
One Book, One Federation
