The teaching philosophy of Alliance Française de Tulsa is that language is best taught by the *immersion experience* in the French language. In small intimate groups, students learn French in lively interactive classes.

Beginner classes are designed for students with no or very little French language experience. Students develop elementary French listening skills, acquire basic pronunciation ability, learn names of common objects and verbs of movement, and practice typical conversation exchanges.

Advanced beginner classes are designed for students with some previous French experience. The classes reinforce elementary French skills and further develop listening, comprehension and expression skills in French. Students become more skillful presenters in written and oral French.

Intermediate classes are designed for students with significant French experience. Students converse comfortably in casual simple conversations. The classes further develop all French language skills, so the student is comfortably reading, reciting and comprehending popular French literature. More complex grammar study broadens the students' self-expression in French. Classes explore special themes, such as French cinema or travel in France.

Advanced classes are designed for students who are “nearly” fluent in French. The students explore French culture, literature and history. The advanced classes prepare students for competency tests and professional classes in French.
